EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

License Agreement with The City of Plantation

For a number of years, The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) utilized space at the Jim Ward Community Center, 301 Northwest 46th Avenue, Plantation, Florida 33317, via an agreement to conduct English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) classes. The last agreement was from August 14, 2006 through May 31, 2007, and thereafter was incorporated into the Reciprocal Use Agreement (RUA) between the SBBC and the City of Plantation. However, the RUA with the City expired in 2012. The RUA has not been renewed because the City desires a zero cost RUA with the SBBC, where neither party pays any cost.

If approved by the Board, this Agreement would be for one year, with plans to continue to renew for one year periods until a new RUA can be entered into between the SBBC and the City. Also, provisions in this Agreement states that the SBBC will not pay rent or operational cost for use of the facility.
