AGREEMENT EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Project Description	Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) seeks to improve French instruction at three elementary schools – James S. Hunt Elementary, Riverland Elementary and Tedder Elementary. These schools benefit from a highly diverse student population and more than 231 students participating in French instruction. Riverland Elementary is also a Communications and Language Arts magnet school. A grant from the FACE Foundation would greatly improve authentic French instruction by providing teachers with professional development and a proven French curriculum and enriching the students' classroom experience through an improved francophone environment inclusive of French books, DVDs and games. Age appropriate French curriculum, teachers' guides, textbooks, workbooks, and materials are being sought, including Let's Speak French, Skill Builders French, My First French Phrases, World of Reading, Vitamine 1 Student Book, and other books and materials.				
Evaluation Plan	The project directly addresses one of the Foundation's key objectives of improving and strengthening existing French dual language and immersion tracks. The success of this project will be measured through the provision grade-level appropriate French curriculum, textbooks, and workbooks and students' use of French books, DVDs, and games.				
Research Methodology	Currently the Bilingual/ESOL Department does not have additional funding in its budget to support elementary language instruction or materials. The teachers struggle to obtain grade-level appropriate French curriculum for instruction and accompanying materials for classroom activities. The community has expressed interest in these programs and the schools would increase enrollment by enhancing the quality of these programs.				
Alignment with Strategic Plan	The grant activities are aligned with District Goal 1: High-Quality Instruction by improving the capacity of teachers to provide rigorous French instruction (Literacy and Early Learning). This grant also supports District Goal 3: Effective Communication through improved community engagement.				
Level of Support provided by GAGP	Level 2 – GAGP staff negotiated contract language with the funder and shepherded the contract through the local legal review process.				



GRANT AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

FACE Foundation Inc., 972 Fifth Avenue, New York, NY 10075, represented by Mr. Laurent Auffret, Executive Director, hereafter referred to as "FACE".

AND

The School Board of Broward County, Florida

represented by Victoria Saldala, Director of Bilingual/ESOL Education

Whereas the statutes of the FACE French Dual Language Fund, approved by FACE's Board of Trustees on October 4, 2015,

Whereas the request for a FACE French Dual Language Fund grant for the project "Broward Improves French Immersion and Dual Language Program"

Whereas the decisions made at the meeting of the FACE French Dual Language Fund Selection Committee on October 26, 2018,

Whereas the vote by FACE's Board of Trustees on November 8, 2018, to approve and implement these decisions,

IT HAS BEEN AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: Grant

Based on the FACE French Dual Language Fund Selection Committee's decision, FACE will confer a grant to The School Board of Broward County, Florida in the amount of \$7,000 (seven thousand U.S. dollars) for the project "Broward Improves French Immersion and Dual Language Program"

The grant will be used exclusively to cover expenses related to the project "Broward Improves French Immersion and Dual Language Program" by The School Board of Broward County, Florida

Article 2: Payment

A check payable to **The School Board of Broward County, Florida** in the amount of \$7,000 (seven thousand U.S. dollars) will be issued by FACE once the present agreement has been signed and according to the dates of the project, at the latest one month before the project begins.

Article 3: Communication

The School Board of Broward County, Florida. agrees to acknowledge the French Dual Language Fund and to include the FACE logo available at as well as the logo of the Cultural Services of the French Embassy available at

FACE Foundation Inc.

http://frenchculture.org/logos on all publications, announcements and other communications materials (website, newsletters, etc.) related to the project. In addition, all pedagogical materials purchased (books, posters) that are stored in a public space must have a sign or plaque displaying the aforementioned logos.

The School Board of Broward County, Florida agrees to acknowledge the French Dual Language Fund as follows:

[supported by.] The French Dual Language Fund, a program of the FACE Foundation Inc. in partnership with the Cultural Services of the French Embassy in the United States.

Article 4: Final Report

Within one month after the completion of the program The School Board of Broward County, Florida agrees to provide FACE with:

- A detailed accounting for the expenses directly related to the grant, as well as a complete budget for the entire project.
- b) A final report on the project indicating the number of participants and the resulting outcomes (production, etc.)
- c) Programs, press releases and press reviews, as well as any additional materials (videos, translations, etc.).

Article 5: Project Cancellation or Postponement

Should the project be cancelled **The School Board of Broward County, Florida** agrees to notify **FACE** within one week of the cancellation and to return any remaining or uncommitted funds within 45 days of the date of cancellation.

Should the project be postponed for more than 12 months, or, should there be changes in its basic components (materials, programs, etc.), this information is to be communicated immediately to the Program Director of the Fund in writing. Distribution of the grant will be contingent on the Selection Committee's approval of the changes.

Article 6: SBBC Disclosure of Education Records and Employee Information.

Although no student education records shall be disclosed pursuant to this Agreement, should FACE come into contact with education records during the course of contracted responsibilities, these records are confidential and protected by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and state laws and may not be used or re-disclosed. Any use or re-disclosure may violate applicable federal and state laws. Likewise, no employee information shall be disclosed by The School Board of Broward County, Florida to FACE. Should vendor come into contact with employee information, it may not be re-disclosed except as required or permitted by law.
