POSTING OF Select One RECOMMENDATION/TABULATION: Select One Recommendations and Tabulations will be posted in the Procurement & Warehousing Services and www.Demandstar.com on January 16, 2019 @3:00 pm and will remain posted for 72 hours. Any person who is adversely affected by the decision or intended decision shall file a notice of protest, in writing, within 72 hours after the posting of the notice of decision or intended decision. The formal written protest shall be filed within ten (10) days after the date the notice of protest is filed. Failure to file a notice of protest or failure to file a formal written protest shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under this chapter. Section 120.57(3)(b), Florida Statutes, states that "The formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based." Saturdays, Sundays, state holidays and days during which the District is closed shall be excluded in the computation of the 72-hour time period provided. Filings shall be at the office of the Director of Procurement & Warehousing Services, 7720 West Oakland Park Boulevard, Suite 323, Sunrise, Florida 33351. Any person who files an action protesting an intended decision shall post with the School Board, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond, payable to The School Board of Broward County, Florida, (SBBC), in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the estimated value of the contract. Failure to post the bond required by SBBC Policy 3320, Part VIII, Purchasing Policies, Section N, within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of the right to protest.

(*) The Cone of Silence, as stated in the ITB is in effect until it is approved by SBBC. The Board meeting date stated above is tentative. Confirm with the Purchasing Agent of record for the actual date the Cone of Silence has concluded.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 6A-1.012(12)(c), FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE; PART II, SECTION J OF SCHOOL BOARD POLICY 3320; AND GENERAL CONDITION 6 OF ITB 19-088R, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR BID 19-088R BE REJECTED. ITEM WILL BE REBID AT A LATER DATE, WITH REVISED SPECIFICATIONS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SCHOOL BOARD POLICIES AND PROCEDURES.

Procurement received two responses.

- The response of The Flying Locksmiths is non-responsive and should be rejected as it failed to submit the Bid Summary Sheet before 2:00 p.m. Eastern Time (ET) at Procurement & Warehousing Services on 12/10/2018 as required by the Invitation to Bid (ITB) at page 1, "Submittal Requirements", includes the Bid Summary Sheet.
- The response of M.C & M Construction Corp. is non-responsive and should be rejected as three out of the four references provided were contacted, but none of them have done work with M.C & M Construction Corp. The other reference did not respond. As per Section 4, Special Conditions:
 - "16. BIDDER'S REFERENCES: Bids will be considered only from firms engaged in providing the services specified herein. On "Exhibit C", bidders must provide with the bid, a list of references from three established firms for whom bidder has provided services that are similar in scope and nature to the items listed in the bid summary sheet. Firms must be located within the tricounty area (Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach Counties)."

Section 6A-1.012(12)(c), Florida Administrative Code, and Part II, Section J of School Board Policy 3320 permit a district school board to reject all proposals if less than two responsive proposals for a commodity or contractual services are received.
