Project Description	<p>Under the agreement, the District agrees to participate with FAU in the work of designing, implementing, and supporting a high-quality master’s program along with in-service professional development developed to strengthen principal supervisors through enhanced training.</p> <p>This second amendment extends the District’s participation in the initiative for an additional two years. The Amendment begins March 5, 2019 and ends on December 31, 2020.</p> <p>In this second amendment, FAU agrees to pay the District up to \$128,490 in years three and four of the UPPI. This brings the four-year total contract value to \$425,055. The District is providing in-kind cost sharing as part of this Second Amendment in the amount of \$31,363 over years three and four.</p>
