

Executive Summary

The Florida Consent Decree and State Rule 6A.6.0905 requires each school district to submit an English Language Learner (ELL) Plan to the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) describing the District's proposed procedures and methodologies for serving ELLs which must receive the Commissioner of Education's approval prior to program implementation.

The FLDOE shall review each school district's ELL Plan and approve, disapprove, or return for clarification or further elaboration within sixty (60) days of submission. A school district's ELL Plan shall be updated and resubmitted every three (3) years. The new ELL Plan will be implemented beginning July 1, 2019.
