

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

### **Recreation License Agreement between The School Board of Broward County, Florida and the City of Pompano Beach**

Recreation License Agreements (RLA) are long term agreements that are structured to allow for the long-term continuous use of facilities identified in the RLA. The term of RLAs vary, but typically range from twenty (20) to fifty (50) years.

This RLA will allow the City of Pompano Beach (City) to make improvements, at its sole expense, to construct recreational facilities on a portion of The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) owned land at the Cross Creek School for the City resident's use after school hours. Also, while School is in session, the School will have access to and use of the recreational facilities and additionally, the park improvements constructed by the City on the City owned property, the recreational facilities, and park improvements as depicted in Exhibit B. The City desires to enter into this RLA for twenty-five (25) years.

The City has an eleven million-dollar (\$11,000,000.00) budget for this Project to upgrade the recreational facilities and expand the City owned McNair Park that is adjacent to Cross Creek School. The City will maintain all City improvements on the School grounds. The School Principal has been consulted, has attended pertinent meetings on the project, and is in favor of the City's proposed improvements (see Exhibit 3).

The City's timeline for the project is attached herein as Exhibit 4. Also, it should be noted that in addition to the RLA, the City for years has had partnership agreements with SBBC, and currently has a Reciprocal Use Agreement (RUA) with SBBC.
