\$13,000 for Custom Solution – Why now?


Phase 1 & 2 of the SII App which displays individual student accommodations based on educational plans in Canvas was recently completed. This new functionality allows teachers to view individual student program participation within Canvas courses (i.e. the gradebook and when editing an assignment, discussion, or quiz). The need to validate a teacher “user” being added to a course is necessary to ensure that only teachers or staff are added into Canvas courses with the capability of seeing this information (i.e. not students enrolled as teachers in manually created club courses able to see other student data). See Appendix A, Coordination of Canvas Custom Configurations. The SII App is a finalist in the IMS Global Learning Impact Award!

Why additional funding requests for personnel?

We continue to expand the functionality of Canvas past the original contracted scope. For example, the completion of all phases of the SII App listed below:

- SII APP Phase 1: Add program participation codes into the Canvas gradebook.
- SII APP Phase 2: Add individual and class accommodations into the editing of an assignment, discussion or quiz.
- SII APP Phase 3: Expansion of the SII App to include ELL (Ellevate), ESE (PCG), 504 plans (Accelify), health plans, RTI-Academics & RTI-Behavior plans (BASIS) so that teachers have one platform for all student accommodations, rather than having to go to multiple sources for information.

- ELL (English Language Learner), as indicated by an E
- RTI-A (Response to Intervention – Academic), as indicated by an RA
- RTI-B (Response to Intervention – Behavior), as indicated by an RB
- Gifted, as indicated by a G
- 504 Plan, as indicated by a 5
- Health Conditions, as indicated by an H
