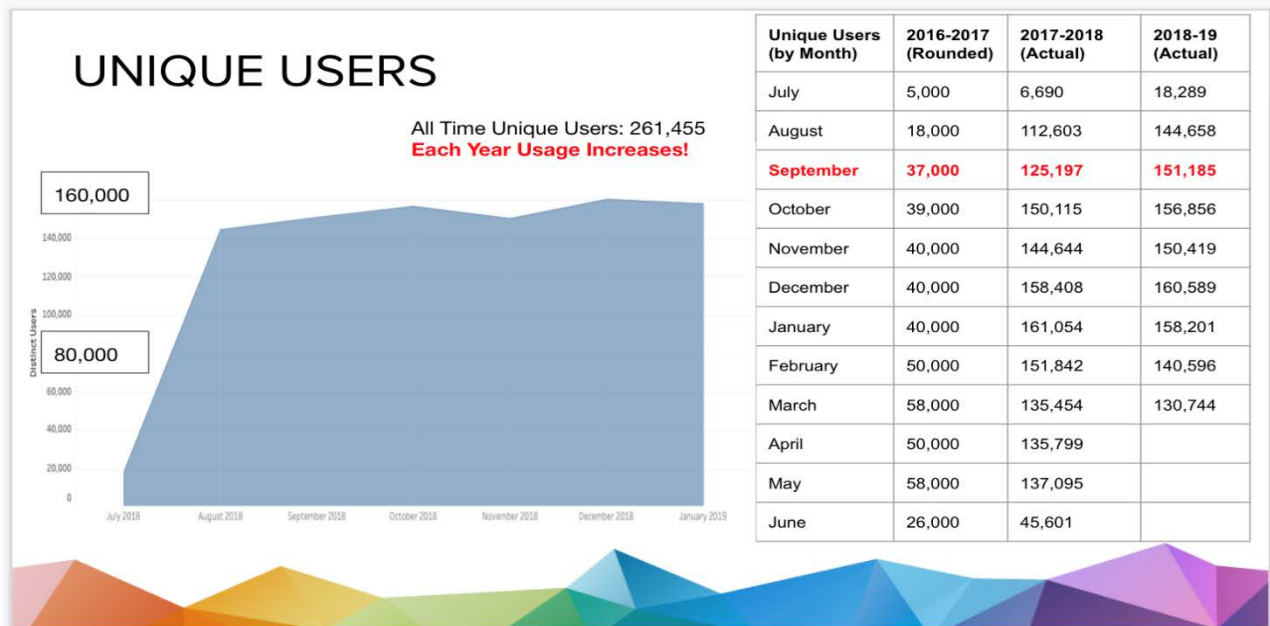


Topic: Instructure Canvas Learning Management System

Staff follow-up: EE-22. Staff to provide Canvas utilization in order to identify the percentage of teachers regularly using Canvas. Staff also to outline its plan for expanding utilization and whether it intends to partner with the teacher's union to expand utilization. (Board SBOM-050719-25)

Response:

(1) Unique Canvas Logins: Each year the numbers of teachers and students accessing Canvas continues to grow.



(2) Percentage of Teachers with Published Courses for Student Use

- High School: 54%
- Middle School: 55%
- Elementary School: 22%
- Centers: 26%

(3) Total Content Created for Student Use

- Assignments: 453,878
- Quizzes: 130,531
- Discussions: 101,726
- Modules: 104,989

(1) BTU: We are currently partnered with BTU

- BTU staff received Canvas training on how to utilize Canvas for communication and newsletters. Innovative Learning provided BTU with accounts and a Canvas course shell.
- BTU has partnered with the ESLS department providing feedback on the Student Information Impacts App (SII App) integration in Canvas which provides teachers the knowledge of the various educational plans for students in their class.
- BTU supported the creation of the Support Staff Role (ESE Specialist, Guidance, Literacy Coach, etc.) in Canvas. This role allows direct access to Canvas courses for the students they support.
- BTU is supporting the initiative to provide substitutes access to Canvas courses.

(2) Currently expanding utilization via:
