GENERAL OVERVIEW:

The Professional Services Agreement was approved by the Board on January 17, 2018 (Agenda Item JJ-5).

The purpose of this Second Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with Song & Associates, Inc., is to address the scope revisions to follow, which will result in a net increase to the Basic Services Fees in the amount of \$18,990 and an increase to the Allowances for reproduction expenses in the amount of \$2,000 for a total increase in the amount of \$20,990.

The original scope of work included installing fire sprinklers for Buildings 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 85. The District's Chief Fire Official determined that Building 4 was the only building that required fire sprinklers. Buildings 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 85 did not require fire sprinklers, and therefore, the District's Chief Fire Official requested this scope of work be removed from the construction documents. This resulted in a credit to the Basic Fees in the amount of \$13,500.

During the Chief Fire Official's review of this campus, it was requested that secondary means of egress exits be furnished for classrooms that have space greater than 1,000sq/ft. Song & Associates, Inc. has identified 26 classrooms in Buildings 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10, and has agreed to provide Basic Services for this additional scope for an increase to Basic Services Fees in the amount of \$16,590.

The remaining fire sprinkler scope for Building 4 requires an increase in Basic Services Fees for Civil Engineering Services. Song & Associates, Inc. has agreed to provide these Civil Engineering Services for an increase to Basic Services Fees in the amount of \$15,900.

This Amendment has been reviewed and approved as to form and legal content by the Office of the General Counsel.

Basic Fees, to provide Architectural, Structural and Electrical Design for 26 egress exits for an increase of \$16,590 in Basic Fees and to provide civil engineering services for Fire Sprinkler scope for Building 4 for an increase of \$15,900 in Basic Fees for a total net increase in Basic Fees for design services in the amount of \$18,990; and

WHEREAS, an increase to the Allowance for Reproduction Expenses in the amount of \$2,000 is also required.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein and the sums of money agreed to be paid by the Project Consultant to the Owner, the parties agree as follows:

- The recitals contained herein are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Revised Terms. The Project Consultant shall delete the Fire Sprinkler portion of the Scope of Work in Buildings 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 85, provide Architectural, Structural and Electrical Design for 26 egress exits and provide civil engineering services for Fire Sprinkler scope for Building 4 as set forth below:

 - b) the First Amendment to Agreement; then
 - c) the Agreement.
- 5. Authority: Each person signing this Second Amendment on behalf of either party warrants that he or she has full legal power to execute this Second Amendment on behalf of the party for whom he or she is signing it to bind and obligate such party with respect to all provisions contained in this Second Amendment


