

Executive Summary

Broward County Public Schools has 24 elementary schools in the “Lowest 300 Performing Elementary Schools” category, two of which are charter schools:

- Innovation Charter School
- New Life Charter Academy

One charter schools has been removed from the “Lowest 300 Performing Elementary Schools” category:

- Bridgeprep Academy

Nineteen district elementary schools are in the “Lowest 300 Performing Elementary Schools” category from the 2018/19 school year and will now have a 6.5 hour instructional day:

There are three additional District elementary schools which fall under the “Lowest 300 Performing Elementary Schools” category for the 2018/19 school year:

Seven of our District elementary schools were removed from the “Lowest 300 Performing Elementary Schools” category and times have been reduced accordingly for the 2019/20 school year:

- Lake Forest
- Oakland Park
- Park Lakes
- Plantation
- Tedder
- Watkins
- Westwood Heights

As a result of the 2019/20 “Lowest 300 Performing Elementary Schools” changes, transportation was able to minimize the cost impact to the District by adjusting the bell times 10 minutes for North Lauderdale Elementary, Cooper City and Deerfield Beach High schools, 45 minutes for Whiddon-Rogers Education Center, and 15 minutes for Seagull School.
