Project Description	<p>Workforce Education fees are established by the Legislature in the General Appropriations Act. The School Board must annually adopt a Postsecondary Fee Schedule which includes fees for Community Education programs, as set forth by the District. Approximately 175,000 students enroll annually in Career, Technical, Adult and Community Education programs, courses and activities.</p> <p>The fee schedule, in addition to listing all Career Technical Education (CTE) and Adult General Education (AGE) programs to be offered in School Year 2019-2020, provides a general overview of the guidelines and procedures that the eight Workforce Education Schools must follow. The tuition rate for CTE/AGE programs will remain the same rate per hour as what was charged in School Year 2018-2019.</p>
