

**Resolution # 20 - 100**

**Declare the Westerly 0.0147 Acre Portion of Land at the New River Middle School Site as Surplus**

**WHEREAS**, Florida Statutes 1013.28, subject to the rules of the State Board of Education, allows a board to dispose of any land or real property that is, by resolution of the board, determined to be unnecessary for educational purposes as recommended in an educational plant survey; and

**WHEREAS**, The School Board of Broward County, Florida has determined that the Westerly 0.0147-acre portion of the New River Middle School is unnecessary for educational purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, The Westerly 0.0147 acre portion of the New River Middle School is currently recommended for disposition in the Educational Plant Five Year Survey Report, Broward County School District 2015-2020 (Plant Survey).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by The School Board of Broward County, Florida:

SECTION 1                    That it is deemed that the 0.0147-acre portion of the New River Middle School located to the rear most Westerly section of the property line for the property address located at 3100 Riverland Road, within the City of Fort Lauderdale, is unnecessary for educational purposes; and therefore, is hereby declared surplus and should be disposed of.

SECTION 2                    That the real property is legally described in the attached Exhibit "A".
