Evidence Based Curriculums/Programs

Dating Matters/Safe Dates: a 6-10 session, healthy relationship, dating violence prevention curriculum, grades 6-10

Get Real About Violence: 8-12 session anger management, violence prevention curriculum, grades K- 12

LEAPs: an online instrument providing comprehensive lesson plans and interactive multi-modal assessment tools, grades K-12

Olweus Bullying Prevention Program: an intensive 3-year prevention program which embeds a culture of respect and safety amongst staff and students, grades K-12

Too Good for Drugs and Violence: curriculum to prevent the use of alcohol and drugs while building skills for decision making, communication, media literacy, conflict resolution, and healthy relationships, grades 9-12

Other Bullying Prevention Curriculum

The ABCs of Bullying Prevention Book: contains 3 bullying prevention lessons for every grade level, K-12

Anti-Bullying Days/Weeks/Months of Observance: utilize with corresponding lessons and toolkits, grades K-12

Anti-Defamation League: anti-bias education to create inclusive and violence free schools, grades K-12

Be the 1 Positive School Culture Initiative: a 3-year outline and tools to help schools establish schoolwide, classroom and individual interventions for bullying prevention, grades K-12

BCPS Anti-Bullying Training Modules: annual trainings for BCPS staff, students and parents, grades K-12

Character Education: monthly character newsletter with activities, lessons, and videos, grades K-12

Child Safety Matters, Monique Burr Foundation: lessons educate and empower students with information and strategies to prevent, recognize, and respond appropriately to bullying, cyberbullying, and other digital dangers, grades K-8

Common Sense Education: online curriculum, family activities, and professional development resources, grades K-12

Other Bullying Prevention Curriculum Cntd.

Don't Laugh at Me/Operation Respect: curriculum, music and videos focused on instruction in SEL skills, grades K-12

The Health Teacher: curriculum with numerous lessons related to health including bullying, grades K-12

iSafe: Internet safety and cyberbullying lessons for staff or students, grades K-12

Net Cetera: toolkit, videos and brochures to reduce online risks and stop cyberbullying, grades K-12

Netsmartz: kits, downloadable videos and lessons on Internet safety and cyberbullying, grades K-12

PACER's Toolkits: creative resources and lessons plans, grades K-12

PBS/PBIS: a multitiered framework to reduce bullying through the blending of school-wide positive behavior support, explicit instruction, and a redefinition of the bullying construct, grades K-12

Sanford Harmony: a SEL teaching program cultivating strong classroom relationships between students, grades PreK-6

Say Something, Sandy Hook Promise: a training for children and teens addresses how to recognize signs of an individual who may be a threat to get help, grades 6-12

Start with Hello, Sandy Hook Promise: teaches how to be more socially inclusive and connected to one another, grades K-12

"Stop Bullying Now!": videos, toolkit and activities, grades K-8

The Support Group Method of Bullying Intervention: a 7-step non-punitive group intervention that seeks to reduce bullying by increasing empathy, grades 6-12

Teaching Tolerance: curricula, classroom activities, DVDs, and Film kits, grades K-12

Think B4U Post: an internet etiquette, safety and cyberbullying prevention toolkit with lessons and assemblies, grades 3-12
