# Safe School Officers: Complying with Section 1006.12 Florida Statutes

August 1, 2019





# **Options to Comply with Statute:**

- Establish a school resource officer program through a cooperative agreement with a Law Enforcement Agency;
- 2. Employ a school safety officer commissioned by the school district;
- 3. Participate in the Coach Aaron Feis Guardian Program;
- 4. Contract with a security agency to employ an individual, who meets the statutory criteria, as a school security guard (NEW option this year).

"It is imperative for all charter schools to ensure full compliance with this law requiring at least one [School Safety Officer] SSO be present at their school while it is in session. All charter schools without current coverage have until August 1 to come into compliance for the 2019-20 school year...

For those charter schools that choose to treat our requests for information as optional, our only option going forward will be to use the full extent of the law to ensure compliance."

- 2. This documentation is due by August 1, 2019.
