Item #1 – (COI #3) Remove and replace carpet in room 223E: Existing cabinets were removed in room 223E and it was discovered that portions of the carpet was missing underneath; therefore, the carpet had to be removed and replaced with new. (Unforeseen - \$1,465; Add 0 days)

Item #2 – (COI #6) Demolition and replacement of existing sidewalk and soffit: Demolition of the existing sidewalk to provide a new raised sidewalk for ADA accessibility to the new single point of entry office per the Florida Building Code. In addition, demolition and replacement of the existing soffit is required in order to install the new door frame at the entrance. (Consultant Omission - \$16,808; Add 0 days)

Action Plan:

The design drawings have been modified so that they reflect the changes described above. This change order has been reviewed for entitlement and cost by CBRE | Heery, Inc. and Song & Associates, Inc. with a recommendation for approval. In addition, this Change Order has been reviewed and approved by the Change Order Review Panel (CORP).
