## Supportive Summary Explanation and Background (I-3) Continuation

Section 1002.33(9)(n)1, Florida Statutes, states that "the director and a representative of the governing board shall submit to the sponsor for approval a school improvement plan to raise student performance... The department shall offer technical assistance and training to the charter school and its governing board and establish guidelines for developing, submitting, and approving such plans."

Pursuant to Section 6A-1.099827(5), Florida Administrative Code, the Sponsor shall approve or deny the charter school SIP and notify the charter school in writing within ten (10) calendar days of its decision. The sponsor shall deny a SIP if it does not comply with the nine (9) components outlined in Section 6A-1.099827(4), Florida Administrative Code.

The District's Charter SIP Review Committee conducted SIP trainings and technical assistance sessions to assist the charter schools with the SIP process and content review. The schools and their governing boards are requested to appear before the Sponsor at this public meeting to present their state-mandated School Improvement Plans.

SIPs of the following six charter schools are submitted for approval:

- 1. Championship Academy of Distinction High School (5219)
- 2. Excelsior Charter of Broward (5393)
- 3. Innovation Charter School (5177)
- 4. New Life Charter Academy (5852)
