## BUDGET CALENDAR FISCAL YEAR 2020-21

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Pursuant to Chapter 200.065 of the Florida Statutes, the School District is required to advertise its intent to adopt a tentative District budget and millage levy in a newspaper within 29 days of the July 1, 2020 certification of the tax roll. The Budget Hearing dates are mandated by the Florida Statute 200.065(2) (e) 2. No City or County within Broward County can hold a meeting on the same day.

Resulting from statutory requirement and District Board meeting dates, the following schedule was developed for the District's Budget Calendar:

June 16, 2020	4th Budget Board Workshop: To discuss the 2021 Preliminary Budget and gather input from the School Board.		
July 1, 2020	Broward County Property Appraiser's Office approved certified tax roll.		
July 14, 2020	Memorandum informing the School Board of the Tentative District Budget & Millage Levy advertisement based on the State's established millage levy for the District.		
July 21, 2020 & July 22, 2020	Advertisement of the Tentative District Budget for the Fiscal Year 2021.		
July 23, 2020 (Thursday)			
July 23, 2020	1st Public Budget Hearing, after 5:00 p.m.		
September 1, 2020	Capital Budget Final DEFP #2, after 5:00 p.m.		
September 9, 2020	Final Public Budget Hearing, after 5:00 p.m.
