Rationale:	The job description for Classroom Assistant, K-12/Bilingual, has been created in support of the Division of Academics. This position is responsible for providing bilingual instructional assistance in the classroom by assisting with a variety of activities including the preparation of instructional materials, providing supplemental instructional support, performing various clerical duties, and assisting and supervising the actions of students to enrich the delivery of education to students. The job description defines the performance responsibilities and the minimum education and experience required to perform successfully in the job.
