Section 4.2 says failure to provide the information requested will result in the disqualification of proposal; therefore, the submitted proposal is disqualified.

Reject the entire proposal from <u>Therapy Care Ltd</u>. In accordance with Section 4.2, Subsection 4.2.2, Proposer must provide a sample of candidates that have a current/active professional license for Speech-Language Pathology/Audiology issued by the Department of Health from the State of Florida number(s) and submit a copy of the State of Florida license number(s) as required by this RFP. Therapy Care did provide one Speech-Language Pathologist, Mr. Ed Strugalla, M.H.S.,CCC-SLP, there was no SLP license provided from the Department of Health, State of Florida. His name did not come up at the Department of Health, State of Florida website. Also, Therapy Care did not respond to Section 4.2.2, Minimum Eligibility in their proposal. Section 4.2 says failure to provide the information requested will result in the disqualification of proposal; therefore, the submitted proposal is disqualified.

Reject offer for Section 4.4.3.2 - Audiologist from <u>HealthPro Pediatrics, LLC</u>. Section 4.4.3.2 states that the unit price must not exceed \$59.00/hr. Proposer offered \$65.00/hr for an Audiologist; therefore, the services for an Audiologist is disqualified.
