Broward County Public Schools Waiver for Professional Study Days



Broward County Schools is the largest fully accredited school district in the United States

School Improvement Waivers are designed to remove barriers to school improvement that have been found in state statute, school board policy, or collective bargaining contract (see School Board Policy #1403). Waivers must be based on sound educational research and evaluation, must be budget neutral to the district, must be supported by stakeholders in the local school community, and must be approved by 66.67% of the faculty. Waivers may be approved for up to five years by the School Board, but the faculty must approve the waiver each year. Waivers must be equitable for all students in a particular student group.

- 5. The School Advisory Council voted on the **Professional Study Days** Waiver by 100% (minimum of 51%) on 12/10/2019.
- 6. The Faculty voted on the implementation of **Professional Study Days** by 84% (minimum of 66 2/3%) on 01/16/2020, according to the voting guidelines in the Broward Teachers Union Contract, Article 15.
- 7. Write the exact language of the school board policy or contract article that the proposed waiver will supersede.

Article 5.V.1. The District shall provide that the students at each school shall be dismissed two hours early on six days during the school year.

8. State the waiver: change, delete, or add to the policy or contract so as to fulfill the requirements of the proposed waiver.

In addition to the six early release days currently scheduled, the district shall provide that students at Everglades High School be dismissed three hours early for up to eight (8) additional days during the school year for the purpose of high school reform. The professional development will occur for 2.5 hours on each of these additional days. We are requesting this waiver to be approved for 5 years. the school will analyze the data each year to determine whether to continue the waiver as is, adjust the number of days requested or discontinue the waiver.

9. State the rationale for the proposed waiver. How will the proposed waiver support school improvement? Give background information, history of barrier, etc.

Everglades High School began Professional Learning Communities several years ago, however due to the increased importance of having common planning and professional collaboration by teachers, the opportunity for meaningful, consecutive and paid professional development time is insufficient under the current model. For a high school of over 100 teachers with more than 2300 students to become an authentic and effective learning community with common goals, additional professional development time is necessary to meet the rigorous demands expected of our staff and students. From 2014-2019, EHS approved up to eight additional days for our staff. These additional professional development days enhanced the educational environment and collegiality of our staff. The result of our hard work could be seen immediately as EHS is an A school.

10. Recognizing that one strategy alone does not affect school-wide achievement, identify and explain the baseline data for the proposed waiver.

The baseline data driving Everglades' waiver request is as follows (2019-2020): 64% of students performed at a satisfactory level or higher in reading. 54% of students performed at a satisfactory level or higher in math. 72% of students performed at a satisfactory level or higher in science. 54% of students made learning gains in reading. 58% of students in the lowest 25 percentile made learning gains in math EOC. 41% of students in the lowest 25 percentile made learning gains in reading. 43% of students in the lowest 25 percentile made learning gains in math. 66% High School Acceleration Performance (2019) 81% of students performed at a satisfactory level or higher on the U.S. EOC in 2019. 96%: Four Year Graduation Rate in 2019. As can be seen from the preceding data, EHS has much room for improving student academic performance. We believe that providing more opportunities for our teachers to grow professionally is critical to achieving that goal.
