
MONTH IN REVIEW

Small businesses are an essential constituent of the Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) community and South Florida's economy. Annually, the District engages the services of hundreds of small, minority, and women-owned firms, many of which are facing an existential threat as supply and demand mirror the adverse effects of the pandemic. Small businesses are the employers of the parents, guardians, and caretakers of BCPS students. According to the U.S. Small Business Administration Office of Advocacy, they account for <u>44 percent of the U.S. economic activity</u>, <u>43.5 percent of gross domestic products</u>, support the economic growth, vitality, and diversity of our local communities as job creation powerhouses and are the drivers of innovation and competitiveness.



The Economic Development & Diversity Compliance (EDDC) Department continues to uphold the business community to positively impact our students. The department is committed to providing a

supportive environment that promotes sustainability for the District's suppliers through weekly informational updates on available funding sources, procurement opportunities, outreach calls, and business support services. In the last 30 days, EDDC has reached more than 700 suppliers.

In collaboration with our community partners, the EDDC team remains focused on delivering core services remotely to include emerging/small/minority/women business enterprise certifications, internal and external bids notifications, one-on-one technical assistance, targeted outreach for all segments of our business population, and assisting buying agencies with identifying certified suppliers.

COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS



The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) issued a proclamation recognizing the Health Foundation of South Florida, in partnership with Citi Community Development, for leading the South Florida Anchor Alliance (SFAA). Similarly, the SBBC recognized the Urban League of Broward County (ULBC), a convening partner in the SFAA, for its impact on small and diverse businesses through the Entrepreneurship Center and collaborations with partner institutions.

The EDDC will work closely with these organizations in its mission to grow the economic base for the benefit of BCPS students and the business community.







The SFAA consists of Broward County and Miami-Dade County public and private sector agencies and anchor institutions working to increase economic development opportunities for underutilized local, small, and women-owned businesses and workforce development for residents in the South Florida region.

The Urban League of Broward County Entrepreneurship Center is a business development platform for minority and women-owned businesses in South Florida, providing education and capital to strengthen capacity and increase business opportunities.



FUNDING OPTIONS



<u>SBA FIDL EMERGENCY ADVANCE</u> will provide up to \$10,000 of economic relief to businesses that are currently experiencing temporary difficulties.

<u>SBA PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM</u> provides loan forgiveness for retaining employees by temporarily expanding the traditional SBA 7(a) loan program.

<u>SBA EXPRESS BRIDGE LOANS</u> enables small businesses who currently have a business relationship with an SBA Express Lender to access up to \$25,000 quickly.

SBA DEBT RELIEF PROGRAM will provide a reprieve to small businesses as they overcome the challenges created by the COVID-19 health crisis. Under this program, the SBA will pay the principal and interest of new 7(a) loans issued before September 27, 2020. The SBA will also pay the principal and interest of current 7(a) loans for six months.




