

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Recommendation to Approve Agreement FY21-102 – Unity Computer Science-Spatial Computing Program

Introduction

Responsible: Procurement & Warehousing Services (PWS)

This request is to approve the agreement between Unity Technologies ApS and The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC), for one (1) year, starting July 21, 2020 and expires on August 3, 2021. The agreement will provide virtual, instructor-led training that will enable SBBC's teachers to teach, instruct, and prepare students to earn their Unity Certification during the 2020-2021 academic year.

The Agreement resulted in a cost avoidance of \$12,000 for the District.

Goods/Services Description

Responsible: Career, Technical, Adult and Community Education (CTACE)

The Teacher Professional Development program, hosted by UTECH, to virtually train Broward high school computer science teachers to become Unity Certified Users so that they may successfully instruct and prepare students to earn the same Unity Industry Certification during the 2020-2021 school year. A four (4) days virtual professional development program for approximately thirty (30) teachers.

Procurement Method

Responsible: PWS

Pursuant to the Department of Education, Rule 6A-1.012, 11(b), Florida Administrative Code as authorized by Section 1010.04(4)(a), Florida Statutes, and Purchasing Policy 3320, Section II, G, the requirement for requesting competitive solicitation for commodities or contractual services from three (3) or more sources is hereby waived as for the SBBC's purchase of educational services.

Financial Impact

Responsible: PWS and CTACE

The Agreement resulted in a cost avoidance of \$12,000 for the District.
