

NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE

The School Board of Broward County, Florida will soon consider a measure to increase its property tax levy.

Last year's property tax levy

A portion of the tax levy is required under state law in order for the school board to receive \$815,738,874 in state education grants. The required portion has decreased by 2.03 percent and represents approximately six tenths of the total proposed taxes.

The remainder of the taxes is proposed solely at the discretion of the school board.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing to be held via electronic communication on the tax increase to be held on July 28, 2020, at 5:30 P.M., at the K.C.
