#### SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND CONTINUED

### 1. Policy 5.5-E: STUDENT ATTENDANCE – E-LEARNING

To provide for recording of student attendance during distance learning, which is being provided due to the immediate danger to public health, safety, or welfare presented by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

# 2. Policy 5.8-E: CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT - E-LEARNING

To provide guidance for parents and students regarding dress code responsibilities when students are participating in e-learning and school-sponsored activities due to the immediate danger to public health, safety, or welfare presented by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

## 3. Policy 2170-E: FACE COVERINGS

To provide appropriate guidance for the health and safety of our students, employees, vendors and visitors, to include the wearing of face coverings while they are in District schools, facilities and vehicles due to the immediate danger to public health, safety, or welfare presented by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

### 4. Policy 5306-E: SCHOOL AND DISTRICT TECHNOLOGY USAGE – E-LEARNING

To provide guidance to staff, parents and students regarding privacy issues while participating in e-learning, as well as the recording and storing instructional lessons for future use due to the immediate danger to public health, safety, or welfare presented by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Each of these Policies will be reviewed and re-introduced through the required Rule Adoption and Rulemaking process as established in School Board Policy 1001. New policies will have to be adopted no later than November 17, 2020, at which time the above emergency policies will expire.

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
