## **GENERAL OVERVIEW:**

The Professional Services Agreement was approved by the Board on July 26, 2016 (Agenda Item JJ-1).

The purpose of this Fourth Amendment in the amount of \$377,219 to the Professional Services Agreement with Wolfberg/Alvarez and Partners, Inc., is for adjustments to the Basic Services Fees associated with an increase to the FLCC for the SMART Program Renovations at Piper High School. Included in this Fourth Amendment is a fee credit of \$40,500 due to delays associated with deliverables. This is based on a Construction Bid Recommendation awarded to H.A. Contracting Corp. in the amount of \$14,964,000 that was approved by the Board on February 4, 2020 (Agenda Item JJ-2).
