

DOE continues to monitor both Black and Hispanic students in the areas listed below. For the 2019-2020 school year, data reveals that the District increased minority enrollment as noted:

Dual Enrollment (10-12th) grades

Black Students enrollment increased from (5%) in 2015-2016 SY to (11%) in 2019-2020 SY, which represents a total increase of (6%).

Hispanic Students enrollment increased from (7%) in 2015-2016 SY to (11%) in 2019-2020 SY, which represents a total increase of (4%).

AP/IB/AICE (9-12th) grades

Black Students enrollment increased from (16%) in 2015-2016 SY to (18%) in 2019-2020 SY, which represents a total increase of (2%).

Hispanic Students enrollment increased from (30%) in 2015-2016 SY to (31%) in 2019-2020 SY, which represents a total increase of (1%).

All Level III Courses (including AP/IB/AICE,DE and Honors) (9-12th) grades

Black Students enrollment increased from (53%) in 2015-2016 SY to (60%) in 2019-2020 SY, which represents a total increase of (7%).

Hispanic Students enrollment increased from (68%) in 2015-2016 SY to (71%) in 2019-2020 SY, which represents a total of (3%).
