Project Overview:

The scope of work for this project, includes, but is not limited to, fire sprinklers, fire alarm, the replacement of existing classroom unit ventilators (approximately 43 classrooms) with new ventilators, ducts and diffusers. This includes all related work including electrical, DDC controls, plumbing, ceiling removal and replacement, test and balance, and replacement of outside air units, provide ventilation for the communications room F110H, building envelope improvements, and media center improvements.

Status of Work:

The project obtained the Certificate of Occupancy on March 30, 2020 and the Certificate of Final Inspection was received from the Building Department on September 15, 2020. All documents for closeout will be executed upon Board approval of this item.

Recommendations/Remarks:

The contractor finished the project within the original time constraints inclusive of the Board approved time extensions, as set forth in the contract. No time extension is required for Final Acceptance. The time variation between final completion and the execution of the OEF 209 is attributed to the change orders that had to be negotiated, settled, and Board approved prior to final execution of the OEF 209 Form.

The contractor has completed all aspects of the contract, all work has been inspected and accepted. The contractor has furnished a properly executed General and Full Release of Lien which is attached as Exhibit 2 to the Agenda Request Form. Retainage shall be released and available to the contractor once this item is approved by The School Board of Broward County.

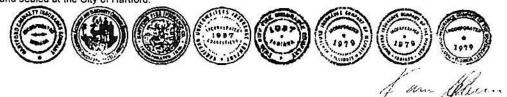
