<b>Project Description</b>	<p>F.S.§ 1006.07(7) requires each district school board to adopt policies for the establishment of behavioral threat assessment teams at each school whose duties include the coordination of resources and assessment and intervention with individuals whose behavior may pose a threat to the safety of school staff or students consistent with the model policies developed by the Office of Safe Schools. Such policies shall include procedures for referrals to mental health services identified by the school district pursuant to F.S.§ 1012.584(4) when appropriate.</p> <p>Policy 2130 governs the District’s practices for the implementation of behavioral threat assessment procedures. It is the intent of The School Board to identify the required actions of each school principal and each school-based threat assessment team, while also ensuring that all employees are held accountable and responsible for the expectations of their position.</p>
