First Amendment to Walgreens Experiential Learning Program Agreement

REQUESTED ACTION:
Approve the First amendment to the agreement between Walgreens Experiential Learning Program dated June 13, 2017 and The School Board of Broward County, Florida.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND:
The amended agreement with Walgreens Experiential Learning Program will provide students who are enrolled in Health Science Education Programs at the three Broward Technical Colleges the opportunity to participate in clinical learning experiences. The results of the surveys indicated an overall rating of 95% as above average. Summary Explanation and Background

This districtwide agreement supports the instructional programs provided by Broward County Public Schools that are necessary to meet Florida Department of Education mandated student performance standards. This agreement also addresses the requirements of regulatory agencies for students to qualify for certification/licensure.

In accordance with a School Board request, the Broward Technical Colleges administer surveys to aid in measuring the effectiveness of the clinical experience. These surveys will be completed by students, Health Science Education teachers, and select staff of the facility. The results of the surveys are used to make recommendations for modifying clinical agreements that will strengthen the student's job-site experience and the overall Health Science Education Program. The results of the surveys indicated an overall rating of 95% above average for each survey question.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO
WALGREENS EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING PROGRAM AGREEMENT**

This FIRST AMENDMENT TO WALGREENS EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING PROGRAM AGREEMENT (as defined herein) (the "First Amendment") is effective the 3rd day of March, 2020, by and between THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, a public institution of higher education, with a principal place of business at 600 Southeast Third Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301 ("Organization"), and WALGREEN CO., an Illinois corporation with a principal place of business located at 200 Wilmot Road, Deerfield, Illinois 60015 ("Walgreen").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Organization and Walgreen entered into that certain Walgreens Experiential Learning Program Agreement, dated June 13, 2017, (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend certain provisions of the Agreement;



NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing promises, the mutual covenants herein considered and each act performed hereunder by the parties, and for other good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency and receipt of which are hereby acknowledged by each of the parties hereto, Organization and Walgreen hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. **Recitals.** The Parties agree that the foregoing recitals are true and correct and that such recitals are incorporated herein by reference.
2. **Amended Provisions.** The Agreement is hereby amended by interlineation to replace **Exhibit A**, with the **Exhibit A** specifically attached and incorporated herein.
3. **Order of Precedence among Agreement Documents.** In the event of conflict between the provisions of the Agreement and the provisions contained herein, the provisions of the following documents shall take precedence in this order:
 - a. This First Amendment; then
 - b. The Agreement
4. **Other Provisions Remain in Force.** Except as specifically modified by this First Amendment, the Agreement and each of its terms shall remain in full force and effect.
5. **Authority.** Each person signing this First Amendment to Agreement on behalf of either party individually warrants that he or she has full legal power to execute this First Amendment to Agreement on behalf of the party for whom he or she is signing, and to bind and obligate such party with respect to all provisions contained in this First Amendment to Agreement.

The undersigned represent and warrant that they are authorized as representatives of the party on whose behalf they are signing to sign this First Amendment to bind their respective party thereto.


