# Summary of Changes to Policy 5006

## Alignment to Florida Statute

- Page 3 - F.S. §1006.13 - Specific to petty acts of misconduct
- Page 5 – F.S. §1006.13 – Updated Zero Tolerance language
- Page 21 – F.S. §1006.13 and School Environmental Incident Reporting – Specific to Battery-aggravated felony, assault/threat (high and serious) incidents
- Page 25-26 – School Environmental Incident Reporting – Battery-aggravated felony and serious injury
- Page 26 - F.S. §1006.13 - Specific to petty acts of misconduct



# Summary of Changes to Policy 5006

## Clarifying Language

- Page 3 - Tobacco/nicotine
- Pages 10-11 – Leaf marijuana
- Page 15 – Being Under the Influence of Unauthorized Substances
- Pages 15-17 – Possession with intent to sell, sale, attempted sale and/or transmittal of leaf marijuana

# Summary of Changes to Policy 5006
