Make-up Work

- **Proposal:** To add external suspensions in the language for make-up work & align language in elementary, middle, and high school sections

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h. Make-Up Work

- 1) Make-up work shall be accepted for full credit and grade for excused, **and** unexcused absences, **and external suspensions**.
- 2) All make-up work must be submitted within two days upon return to the missed class, not including the day of return, for each day of an absence.
- 3) When assignments and appropriate instruction are provided prior to the absence, make-up work (including major projects) is due on the day of return to the missed class.
- 4) Under extenuating circumstances and at teacher's discretion, additional time may be allowed.



Policy 6000.1 Waiver requests due to school closure

- Waive the requirement to sit for the AP, AICE, or IB test to earn 2 quality points for GPA calculation
- Waive current qualifications 3rd Grade Reading Academy (FSA Level 1)
- Third grade portfolio is suspended for the 2019-2020 school year
- Waive service learning requirement for Seniors during 2019-2020
- Modify the Semester 2 exam and EOC exam for final grade calculation

 - Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.)
