## Make-up Work

 Proposal: To add external suspensions in the language for make-up work & align language in elementary, middle, and high school sections

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h. Make-Up Work

1) Make-up work shall be accepted for full credit and grade for excused, and unexcused absences, and external suspensions.

2) All make-up work must be submitted within two days upon return to the missed class, not including the day of return, for each day of an absence.

3) When assignments and appropriate instruction are provided prior to the absence, make-up work (including major projects) is due on the day of return to the missed class.

4) Under extenuating circumstances and at teacher's discretion, additional time may be allowed.



# Policy 6000.1 Waiver requests due to school closure

- Waive the requirement to sit for the AP, AICE, or IB test to earn 2 quality points for GPA calculation
- Waive current qualifications 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Reading Academy (FSA Level 1)
- Third grade portfolio is suspended for the 2019-2020 school year
- Waive service learning requirement for Seniors during 2019-2020
- Modify the Semester 2 exam and EOC exam for final grade calculation
