Goals to be Achieved with Revisions

- **Representativeness** Ensure that TAC's voting membership represents the stakeholders that the District serves in as high a ratio as possible
- **Quorum -** Increase ability to meet quorum given the many schedules that have to align to convene meetings
- Alignment Ensure that language in the document aligns with current organizational structure and conditions (e.g., up to date titles, department names)

Opportunity / Strategic Plan 2024

- A Strategic Opportunity to align with Our Data, Our Tools Campaign that focuses on governance
- Policy 5306.1 defines TAC as an advisory committee within the overall BCPS governance structure (i.e., the Board)
- Policy defines the committee membership; the policy has not been modified in >10 years

Highlighted Corrections to Policy / Bylaws

Policy 5306.1

- Create the opportunity to achieve quorum by removing administrative layers
- Teachers appointed by Level Chairs as opposed to OSPA based on BTU recommendation
- Removed grade level breakdown (Teachers/Administrators)
- Lowered quorum requirements to meet historical attendance numbers
 - Reduced membership from 45 to 32
 - Reduced Quorum from 24 to 17

Driving goal remains: "Maintain diverse community voice while recognizing without a quorum; no voice is represented"

General Feedback

- TAC Committee Readout at Monthly Board Meeting
 - TAC Chairperson will provide more frequently in the future
 - May be submitted electronically

Policy 5306.1

- Re-include PTA
 - PTA/PTO/SAC are aggregated through DAC. We achieve parent representativeness via 4 DAC roles including DAC, ESOL, ESE, & Gifted
- Clarify 3 sentences
 - Union representative changed word "should" to "may"
 - Clarified quorum sentence regarding physical presence
 - Removed the word "senior" from "senior staff"
- Stagger term of non-Board appointees
 - Because IT project planning and implementation follows the cadence of the fiscal year, the administration recommends the current term schedule of non-Board appointees
 - There is no evidence, to date, of a period with many simultaneous vacancies, which would require us to stagger terms
