2019-2020 BTA Trainings

Behavioral Threat Assessment: This three-hour course is for school-based administrators, security specialists, and other instructional staff members (e.g., ESE Specialists, Behavior Specialists). This course provides members of school-based Threat Assessment teams with the competencies necessary to effectively evaluate and respond to threats.

Behavioral Threat Assessment for Mental Health Professionals: This four-hour course is for school-based mental health professionals (e.g., social workers, school psychologists, school counselors, family therapists) who will participate in Behavioral Threat Assessments at schools. This course is designed to provide mental health professionals with the competencies necessary to report and respond to threats. This will also prepare them for the clinical interviewing conducted during the threat assessment process.

Behavioral Threat Assessment for Law Enforcement Officer: This four-hour course is for law enforcement officers, who participate in Behavioral Threat Assessments at schools. The course is designed to provide Law Enforcement Officers with the competencies necessary to assist with school-based behavioral threat assessments, to identify and report potential threats, and to explore their role on these teams. Additional emphasis was placed on disability awareness. These trainings were organized in collaboration with the Broward Sheriff's Office and several other municipalities.
