**POSTING OF ITB RECOMMENDATION/TABULATION:** ITB Recommendations and Tabulations will be posted in the Procurement & Warehousing Services and [www.Demandstar.com](http://www.Demandstar.com) on **MARCH 13, 2020 @ 3:00 pm** and will remain posted for 72 hours. Any person who is adversely affected by the decision or intended decision shall file a notice of protest, in writing, within 72 hours after the posting of the notice of decision or intended decision. The formal written protest shall be filed within ten (10) days after the date the notice of protest is filed. Failure to file a notice of protest or failure to file a formal written protest shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under this chapter. Section 120.57(3)(b), Florida Statutes, states that "The formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based." Saturdays, Sundays, state holidays and days during which the District is closed shall be excluded in the computation of the 72-hour time period provided. Filings shall be at the office of the Director of Procurement & Warehousing Services, 7720 West Oakland Park Boulevard, Suite 323, Sunrise, Florida 33351. Any person who files an action protesting an intended decision shall post with the School Board, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond, payable to The School Board of Broward County, Florida, (SBBC), in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the estimated value of the contract. Failure to post the bond required by SBBC Policy 3320, Part VIII, Purchasing Policies, Section N, within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of the right to protest.

**RECOMMENDATION TABULATION**

IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 6A-1.012(12)(C), FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE; PART II, SECTION J OF SCHOOL BOARD POLICY 3320; AND GENERAL CONDITION 6 OF ITB FY20-196, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR BID FY20-196 BE REJECTED. ITEM WILL BE REBID AT A LATER DATE, WITH REVISED SPECIFICATIONS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SCHOOL BOARD POLICIES AND PROCEDURES.

Procurement received bids from six Bidders: Bell Techlogix, CDW Government LLC, Crayon Software Experts LLC, Insight Public Sector, Inc, SHI International Corp and Zones, LLC along with one No-Bid from Dell Marketing, L.P. After bid opening, it was determined that two items within the groups contained incorrect sku numbers. Four Bidders provided pricing for the incorrect skus based on the item description and two Bidders provided pricing based on the incorrect sku number. Bids could not be evaluated as, award was based on group, not item. Per Special Condition 3.3 : "...bid shall be awarded in its ENTIRETY to one (1) primary and one (1) alternate..."
