Continuation of Summary Explanation and Background:

On June 11, 2019, The School Board of Broward County, Florida, approved a charter application to open a new charter school for the start of the 2020 – 2021 academic year. SunFire High of Fort Lauderdale will serve students in grades 9-12 and will open in August 2020.

Pursuant to Section 1002.33, Florida Statutes, the terms and conditions for the operation of a charter school shall be set forth by the charter school and The School Board of Broward County, Florida, in a written contractual agreement. This agreement shall constitute a school's charter.

In accordance with Florida Statutes, The School Board of Broward County, Florida, shall monitor and review the charter's revenues, expenditures, and progress toward the goals established in the charter.

The Charter School will be located at 1107 NW 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33311, which is in District 5.
