

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The ELC-VPK-20 is the provider agreement between the Early Learning Coalition of Broward County, Inc. (ELC) and the School Board of Broward County (SBBC). The agreement defines District and ELC requirements and responsibilities for participation in the State's Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) program. The District will receive payment (reimbursement) for instructional services provided to enrolled children based upon legislative appropriations found in the Office's Uniform Attendance Policy for Payment [Rule 6M-8.204, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), and A Child's Attendance Certified by the Parent and Provider (Rule 6M-8.305, F.A.C.)].

SBBC will provide full-day (6-hour) and half-day (3-hour) VPK instructional models.

Program models include:

Curriculum, health screenings, instructional supplies, furniture, consumable items, field trips, snacks and instructional support are provided by the Head Start/Early Intervention Department.			

* Summer VPK provides 300 total hours. The number of hours per day varies based upon the number of available summer days, the District's work week, parent feedback and other District summer programs.
