1-Broward County School Board vs. Wyman Lee Gresham 05/05/2020 SSBM

SUMMARY EXPLANATION AND BACKGROUND

On or about December 4, 2017, Wyman Lee Gresham (Gresham) was taken into custody and charged with lewd or lascivious molestation of a victim 12 to 16 years of age and lewd and lascivious conduct by a person 18 years of age or older. Effective December 13, 2017, the School Board placed Gresham on administrative leave.

On or about February 21, 2018, the State of Florida charged Gresham with one count of lewd or lascivious molestation and one count of lewd and lascivious conduct.

On or about February 22, 2018, the Court entered a pre-trial supervision order, which prohibits Gresham from having contact with any minor child that is not related to him by blood or adoption.

Gresham's criminal case is pending. Gresham continues to be paid as a teacher despite that he is prohibited from having contact with minors by Court order.

Superintendent's Counsel prepared the Administrative Complaint and notice was served on Gresham on November 20, 2019, that a recommendation for his termination will be presented to the School Board on December 10, 2019. At its December 10, 2019 meeting, The School Board adopted the Superintendent's recommendation for termination of Gresham's employment.

General Counsel prepared and issued a notice of hearing for May 5, 2020.
