Page (Item)	<b>Recommended Change/Addition/Deletion</b>	Rationale
Page 1, Rule I.d.1.	Add "who has been deceased for a period of not less than two (2) years."	This addition will ensure an entire facility will not be named for a deceased individual until they have been deceased for not less than two (2) years. *Note: Prior to the November 8, 2011 Board Workshop this change previously reflected not less than five (5) years.
Page 1, Rule I.e.	Add "If living, and also an elected official, shall have left public office for a period of time not less than two (2) years. Further, a section of a facility may not be named for persons actively employed by or serving the District."	Current policy extends naming privileges for a section of a facility to a person living or dead. Further, the Policy is silent concerning naming a section of the facility after a current Board Member or employee. This addition supports the District's initiative to ensure no facilities are named for current Board Members or any other employees, and no elected official will be entitled to having a section of a facility named after them for not less than two (2) years after leaving office. *Note: Prior to the November 8, 2011 Board Workshop this change previously reflected not less than five (5) years.

Page1, Rule I.f.	Added "1."	The "1" was added to reflect the addition of "2".
Page1, Rule I.f.	Added "2. Retain the right to rename a facility, if the person the facility was previously named after, did not follow the District's character traits."	This request was added at the request of Board Members to protect the School Board's interest should something negative occur after a facility has been named.
