- c) CONDITION AND PACKAGING: It is understood and agreed that any item offered or shipped as a result of this bid shall be new (current production model at the time of this bid) unless otherwise specified. All containers shall be suitable for storage or shipment and all prices shall include standard commercial packaging.
- d) UNDERWRITERS' LABORATORIES: Unless otherwise stipulated in the bid, all manufactured items and fabricated assemblies shall be UL listed where such has been established by UL for the item(s) offered and furnished. - 11. <u>CONFLICT OF INTEREST:</u> In addition to full and complete adherence to the requirements provided in Chapter 112.313, Florida Statutes, all bidders must disclose with their bid the name of any officer, director, or agent who has a material interest in the bidder's firm and who is also an employee of The School Board of Broward County, Florida.
- 12. INSURANCE: Bidder, by virtue of submitting a bid, shall be in full compliance with paragraph 21: LIABILITY INSURANCE, LICENSES AND PERMITS of the General Conditions. Insurance Requirements are shown in FORMS AND ATTACHMENTS Section of this ITB. Bidder shall take special notice that SBBC shall be named as an additional insured under the General Liability policy including Products Liability.

The insurance policies shall be issued by companies qualified to do business in the State of Florida and grant The School Board of Broward County, Florida thirty days of advanced written notice of a cancellation, expiration or any material change in the specified coverage. The insurance companies must be rated at least A-VI by AM Best or Aa3 by Moody's Investor Service. All policies must remain in effect during the performance of the contract.

- 13. <u>DISPUTES:</u> In case of any doubt or difference of opinion as to the items to be furnished hereunder, the decision of the School Board shall be final and binding on both parties.
- 14. <u>LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS AND REGISTRATIONS:</u> As of the Bid Opening Date, Bidder must have all Licenses, Certifications and Registrations required when performing the services as described herein, in order for Bid to be considered a responsive and responsible Bid. Licenses, Certifications and Registrations required for this Bid shall be as required by Chapter 489, Florida Statutes, as currently enacted or as amended from time to time; by the State Requirements for Educational Facilities (SREF), latest version; and by Broward County, Florida. Bidder must submit a copy of all its current Licenses, Certifications and Registrations required as described herein, either with its Bid or within five working days of notification.

An awardee who has any License, Certification or Registration either suspended, revoked or expired after the date of the Bid Opening, shall provide notice to the Director of Supply Management and Logistics within five working days of such suspension, revocation or expiration. However, such suspension, revocation or expiration after the date of the Bid Opening shall not relieve the awardee of its responsibilities under a contract awarded under this bid.

- 15. PATENTS & ROYALTIES: The awardee, without exception, shall indemnify and save harmless The School Board of Broward County, Florida and it's employees from liability of any nature or kind, including cost and expenses for or on account of any copyrighted, patented, or unpatented invention, process, or article manufactured or used in the performance of the contract, including its use by The School Board of Broward County, Florida. If the awardee uses any design, device, or materials covered by letters, patent, or copyright, it is mutually understood and agreed without exception that the bid prices shall include all royalties or cost arising from the use of such design, device or materials in any way involved in the work.
- 16. <u>OSHA:</u> The awardee warrants that the product supplied to The School Board of Broward County, Florida shall conform in all respects to the standards set forth in the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970, as amended, and the failure to comply with this condition will be considered as a breach of contract.
- 17. SPECIAL CONDITIONS: The Superintendent or Designee has the authority to issue Special Conditions and Specifications as required for individual bids. Any and all Special Conditions that may vary from these General Conditions shall have precedence.
- 18. ANTI-DISCRIMINATION: The bidder certifies that he or she is in compliance with the non-discrimination clause contained in Section 202, Executive Order 11246, as amended by Executive Order 11375, relative to equal employment opportunity for all persons without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin. The School Board of Broward County, Florida, prohibits any policy or procedure which results in discrimination on the basis of age, color, disability, gender, national origin, marital status, race, religion or sexual orientation.
- 19. QUALITY: All materials used for the manufacture or construction of any supplies, materials or equipment covered by this bid shall be new unless otherwise specified. The items bid must be new, the latest model, of the best quality and highest grade workmanship.
- 20. <u>LIABILITY, INSURANCE, LICENSES AND PERMITS:</u> Where awardees are required to enter or go onto School Board property to deliver materials or perform work or services as a result of a bid award, the awardee agrees to The Hold Harmless Agreement stated herein and will assume the full duty obligation and expense of obtaining all necessary licenses, permits and insurance. The awardee shall be liable for any damages or loss to the Board occasioned by negligence of the awardee (or agent) or any person the awardee has designated in the completion of the contract as a result of their bid.

- 23. CANCELLATION: In the event any of the provisions of this bid are violated by the contractor, the Superintendent shall give written notice to the contractor stating the deficiencies and unless deficiencies are corrected within five days, recommendation will be made to the School Board for immediate cancellation. The School Board of Broward County, Florida reserves the right to terminate any contract resulting from this invitation at any time and for no reason, upon giving 30 days prior written notice to the other party.
- 24. <u>BILLING INSTRUCTIONS:</u> Invoices, unless otherwise indicated, must show purchase order numbers and shall be submitted in duplicate to the Accounts Payable Department of The School Board of Broward County, Florida, Suite 304, 7720 West Oakland Park Blvd, Sunrise, Florida 33351-6704. Payment will be made a minimum of 30 days after delivery, authorized inspection and acceptance. When vendors are directed to send invoices to a school, the school will make direct payments to the vendor.
- 25. NOTE TO VENDORS DELIVERING TO OUR CENTRAL WAREHOUSE: Receiving hours are Monday through Friday (excluding legal holidays and days during which the school district administration is closed) 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. ET. This warehouse is no longer accessible by the Seaboard Coast Line siding for rail car routing.
- 26. <u>SUBSTITUTIONS:</u> The School Board of Broward County, Florida WILL NOT accept substitute shipments of any kind. Awardees are expected to furnish the brand quoted in their bid once awarded by the School Board. Any substitute shipments will be returned at the awardee's expense.
- 27. FACILITIES: SBBC reserves the right to inspect the awardee's facilities at any time with prior notice. SBBC may use the information obtained from this in determining whether a bidder is a responsible bidder.

- 48. <u>SBBC ITEM IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM:</u> The five digit, nine digit, or 13 character/digit item number shown in parenthesis at the beginning of an item on the Bid Summary Sheet represents the School Board's identification number for the item. It does not represent any manufacturer/distributor model/part number.
- 49. SBBC PHOTO IDENTIFICATION BADGE:

Background Screening: Awardee agrees to comply with all the requirements of Sections 1012.32 and 1012.465, Florida Statutes, and that Awardee and all its personnel who (1) are to be permitted access to school grounds when students are present. (2) will have direct contact with students, or (3) have access or control of school funds will successfully complete the background screening required by the referenced statutes and meet the standards established by the statutes. Personnel shall include employees, representatives, agents or sub-contractors performing duties under the contract to SBBC and who meet any or all of the three requirements identified above. This background screening will be conducted by SBBC in advance of Awardee or its personnel providing any services. The Parties agree that the failure of Awardee to perform any of the duties described in this section shall constitute a material breach of this RFP/BID entitling SBBC to terminate immediately with no further responsibilities or duties to perform under this Agreement. Awardee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless SBBC, its officers and employees of any liability in the form of physical or mental injury, death or property damage resulting in Awardee's failure to comply with the requirements of this section or Sections 1012.32 and 1012.465, Florida Statutes.

SBBC issued identification badges must be worn at all times when on SBBC property and must be worn where they are visible and easily readable.

Each individual, for whom a SBBC photo identification badge is requested, must fill out the forms that are required, show his/her driver's license and social security card, and must be fingerprinted. A background check will be conducted for each badge applicant. SBBC reserves the right to require additional information, should it be necessary, and to deny the issuance of a badge to an applicant. Any applicant, that has been denied a badge, is prohibited from entering SBBC property as an employee, sub-contractor or agent of a contract awardee. Effective immediately, the total fee for the SBBC photo identification badge, fingerprinting and a FBI background check is currently \$75.00. The Money Order is to be made payable to "The School Board of Broward County, Florida". No Company or Personal Checks, nor Credit Cards are acceptable for these fees. These fees are nonrefundable and are subject to change without notice. Badges are issued for a one year period and must be renewed annually. The renewal date will be one year from date of issuance. Failure to renew the badge, at that time, will result in the vendor being required to re-apply and pay the going rate for badging and fingerprinting.

Badges are to be returned to SIU at the end of the contract or at the time an employee is terminated. Failure to return the badge to SBBC may result in the final payment being withheld until the badges are returned.

- 50. AUDIT AND INSPECTION OF AWARDEE'S DOCUMENTS AND RECORDS: The District or its representative reserves the right to inspect and/or audit all the awardee's documents and records as they pertain to the products and services delivered under this agreement. Such rights will be exercised with notice to the awardee to determine compliance with and performance of the terms, conditions and specifications on all matters, rights and duties, and obligations established by this agreement. Documents/records in any form shall be open to the District or State's representative and may include but are not limited to all correspondence, ordering, payment, inspection, and receiving records, contracts or sub-contracts that directly or indirectly pertain to the transactions between the District and the awardee(s).
- 51. <u>ORIGINAL DOCUMENT FORMAT:</u> Only the terms and conditions of this solicitation as they were released by SBBC, or amended via addendum, are valid. Any modification to any term or condition by a vendor is not binding unless it is expressly agreed to in writing by SBBC.
- 52. CREDIT CARDS: Individual schools and departments may place some orders and utilize, as the form of payment, a District-issued credit card to the extent authorized by the School Board. These orders will be made via phone or fax for direct delivery and billing to the requesting work location. Please note that credit card purchases will benefit all vendors by providing immediate payment (i.e. within 48-72 hours), thereby eliminating the need to submit an invoice to the District's Accounts Payable Department or reconcile receivable balances. For credit card purchases, all vendors must have the capability to accept fax orders, which must be confirmed by calling back the requesting work location to verify prices and obtain a credit card number. Only actual items shipped/delivered can be charged to the credit card account (i.e. no back-orders). All purchase deliveries must include a packing slip or receipt/invoice listing the items and prices of goods delivered. The School Board of Broward County, Florida (hereinafter referred to as "SBBC") desires bids new ICE MACHINES, BINS AND ACCESSORIES as specified herein. Unit prices for Bid Items 1, 2 and 3 shall include installation, set-up, placement, demonstration, warranty and all shipping costs to various schools, departments an centers within Broward county, Florida. Awardee(s) will receive individual purchase orders specifying the school, department or center's name and ship to address.

SBBC locations may issue open (blanket) purchase orders as required. Receipt of open orders does not authorize the release or shipment of any good or service. For all open orders, items will be ordered on an as needed basis through the use of an order form. Shipments received as a result of an open order where an order form has not been released will not be accepted and no cost shall be incurred by SBBC as a result.

- 2. <u>TERM:</u> The award of this bid shall establish a contract for the period **beginning July 1, 2006 and continuing through June 30, 2008.** Bids will not be considered for a shorter period of time. Items will be ordered on an as needed basis. For Bid Items 1, 2 and 3 see Special Condition 24.
- 3. AWARD: Bid shall be awarded by GROUP to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder meeting all specifications, terms and conditions. Any verbal or written information, which is obtained other than, by information in this ITB document or by Addenda, shall not be binding on SBBC.

- 5. CONTRACT EXTENSION: The purpose of this bid is to establish a contract, at firm unit prices, for the purchase of estimated requirements for the items listed. The term of the bid shall be for one year, and may, by mutual agreement between SBBC and the awardee, upon final School Board approval, be extended for two additional one year periods and, if needed, 90 days beyond the expiration date of the final renewal period. - 20. <u>DISCONTINUED ITEM:</u> If a bid item is discontinued by the manufacturer during the period of award and the bid item is not available from either the vendor's or manufacturer's inventory, then the vendor shall advise the Purchasing Department in writing of non-availability of the bid item and shall include complete descriptive, technical literature on the item offered to replace the discontinued bid item and, upon written approval, shall furnish the replacement item at the same firm price offered for the original bid item or at a lower price during the remainder of the period of award. - 22. WARRANTY: Warranties must be provided as specified for each item on the Bid Summary Sheet. Bidder's must make sure that the specified warranties as stated on the Bid Summary Sheet must be incorporated into the unit price of each bid item. All warranties shall cover all materials, labor and transportation charges. All warranty repairs must be performed by an authorized manufacturer's repair station located within the tri-county area (Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach Counties) and performed by a manufacturer authorized technician using only original equipment manufacturer (OEM) parts. Price decreases, as well as increases, must be passed on to SBBC.
