Motion to Amend (Carried)

Motion was made by Ms. Gallagher, seconded by Mrs. Kraft and carried, to amend Article III. Membership, to delete Additionally, 4 students representing the 4 areas of the district shall be appointed by the School Board members, one of which must be the student advisor to the board, and to substitute with language from Policy1.5, The Student Advisor to the School Board or his/her designee shall serve on the Committee, representing his/her geographic area. The Student Advisor shall appoint 3 student Committee members representing the remaining three geographic areas. Dr. Parks was absent. (8-0 vote)

Second Motion to Amend (Carried)

Motion was made by Ms. Gallagher, seconded by Mrs. Kraft and carried, to amend Section 7., page 2, to delete sentence, A parliamentarian shall be appointed to the Diversity Committee by School Board as deemed necessary, but will not be a member of the Diversity Committee, and add sentence, The staff member assigned to the Committee shall be trained in parliamentary procedures and serve as parliamentarian when deemed necessary. Dr. Parks was absent. (8-0 vote)

<u>Third Motion to Amend</u> (Carried)

Motion was made by Ms. Gallagher, seconded by Mrs. Bartleman and carried, to amend Section 5., page 5, sentence to read: Meeting scheduled: all meetings time and places shall be appropriately announced according to Sunshine Law. Members must be advised of change in the established date, time or location. All meetings require notification. Dr. Parks was absent. Mr. Rubinstein was absent for the vote. (7-0 vote)

Fourth Motion to Amend (Carried)

Motion was made by Mrs. Kraft, seconded by Ms. Gallagher and carried, to amend Article II. Purpose, to substitute with language from Policy 1.5. (Include two statements from the introductory portion of the policy as to why it was established, and one statement of language from policy regarding committee functions, which states that the Diversity Committee shall ensure that diversity is being promoted by monitoring the terms of the CCC agreement and making recommendations through the Superintendent to the School Board). Dr. Parks was absent. (8-0 vote)
