SUBJECT: **UPDATE RECYCLING BID**

Since 1992-93, the School Board of Broward County and Broward County Government have provided recycling services to public schools. Approximately 220 schools and administrative facilities receive regular collection pick-ups. The recycling materials primarily consist of commingled paper products including, but not limited to, corrugated containers, white/colored ledger, computer printout, copy paper, newspapers, etc. During fiscal year 2005 (October – September), over 2,499 tons of recyclable material was collected from our schools.

The current contract with Broward County Government expires on June 30, 2006. Broward County Government has put on the street an invitation for bid for recycling services. The bid seeks prices from vendors for providing recycling services to schools including all labor, truck, equipment, fuel and related operational expenses, outdoor collection containers and insurance.
