Per Article II.D of the RFQ:

Padula & Wadsworth Construction, Inc. and Skanska USA Building, Inc. were shortlisted.

RFQ Recommendations and Tabulation will be posted at the Facilities and Construction Management Division, 1700 SW 14th Court, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33312, and will remain posted for seventy-two (72) hours. Any Proposer objecting to such action must comply with Florida Statutes, Chapter 120.57(3). In accordance with Board Policy 3320, VI (n), any person who files a formal written protest shall post with the School Board, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond, payable to The School Board of Broward County, Florida, in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the School Board's estimate of the total volume of the contract. The School Board shall provide the estimated contract amount to the protestant within 72 hours of the notice of protest, excluding Saturdays; Sundays, and other days during which the School Board administration is closed. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed by Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or a failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes. Protest and bond, or other security, shall be filed at the office of the Executive Director, Design Services, Facilities and Construction Management Division, 1700 SW 14th Court, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33312. Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, states that the formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based.
