

2006 – 2007 Choice/SES Time Line of Events

March 2006

- Initial letters to parents via students explaining NCLB and AYP. Letter explains to parents that additional information will be coming to inform them of their options. Address verification also requested.
- NCLB website is added to BrowardSchools.com with key information on NCLB/AYP/School Choice and SES.
- NCLB Office is established in the North Central Area to accept parent forms and field limited questions (754) 321-3030.
- Offer meetings to advise parents of NCLB, AYP and their options.
- A copy of initial NCLB letter is placed in school newsletters.

April 2006

- Continue offering meetings to advise parents of NCLB, AYP and their options
- A copy of the initial NCLB letter is placed in school newsletters (if not accomplished in March).
- Formal NCLB Choice/SES letter sent via US Mail on April 19, 2006 to parents requesting parental intent to exercise Choice or SES option for the 06-07 school year.
- All responses indicating a Choice or SES option for 06/07 must be returned to NCLB Office by May 19, 2006, and entered into the NCLB database.
- Parent reminder of NCLB options via Parent-Link.

May 2006

- Information regarding Choice and SES is presented at Title I Parent Meetings
- Deadline for Choice/SES response to NCLB Office – May 19, 2006
- Choice/SES link is added to Title I web page for Parents and Providers

June/July 2006

- Notification letters sent to parents that have chosen to participate in SES. Letter includes Parent notification of Provider Fair and dates, Provider Selection Form, and a list of all providers and services.
- All Provider information is updated on the Title I website
- Provider informational meeting – July 26 in the Title I office
- Use Parent-Link to remind parents selecting Choice/SES of next steps

August 2006

- SES provider contracts due – August 9
- Parent Link system reminds parents of Provider Fair – August 17 and 18.
- Hold SES Provider Fair for parents in each geographical location - August 22, 23, 24
- Start School Board approval of SES contracts

September 2006

- Continue Board approval of SES contracts
- Once SES contracts are approved, providers are notified
- Second round of SES letters to be sent to parents the week of Sept. 4, 2006.
- Parents are asked to return enclosed postcard within 2 weeks.
- Enter responses into NCLB database
- SES notification letters to be sent to parents that have chosen to participate in SES. Letter includes Parent notification of Provider Fair and dates, Provider Selection Form, and a list of all providers and services.
- Informational meeting for new SES providers - September 20, 2006 (pending release by FDOE)
- Due date for contracts of additional providers - September 29, 2006 (pending release by FDOE)

2006 – 2007 Choice/SES Time Line of Events

October 2006

- SES services should begin by October 15 according (per Senate Bill 772) for all School Board approved providers
- Parent Link system reminds parents of Provider Fair – October 5 and 6.
- Additional SES Provider Fairs for Parents are offered for 2nd enrollment period in each geographical location. Tentative dates are October 9, 10, 11.
- Once SES contracts are approved, providers are notified
- Once provider contracts are approved by board, PDPAs can be completed and tutoring services may begin

November 2006

- New SES providers must begin servicing students by November 30, 2006

December 2006

- If required (per SB 772) a third round of SES letters will be sent to parents during week of December 4, 2006.
- Parents are asked to return postcard within 2 weeks.
- Enter responses into NCLB database
- Prepare SES notification letters to be sent to parents requesting SES services
- SES notification letters to be sent to parents that have chosen to participate in SES. Letter includes Parent notification of Provider Fair and dates, Provider Selection Form, and a list of all providers and services.

January 2007

- Parent Link system reminds parents of Provider Fair – Tentative dates for 2nd week in January
- Additional SES Provider Fairs for Parents are offered for 3rd enrollment period in each geographical location. Tentative dates for 2nd week in January.

February 2007

- District must report Survey 3 data on SES participation
