In response to your e-mail of Friday March 30 2007, please be advised that the proposed mitigation as outlined in my letter of February 15, 2007 is the payment of the Student Station Cost Factor (SSCF) as allowed by School Board policy 1161. While the elementary school does not require mitigation as outlined in my previous correspondence, in order to be consistent with the commitments made by Prestige, they agree to pay the SSCF as outlined below.

Prestige Homes will mitigate the required nine (9) middle school students by the payment of the Student Station Cost Factor; in addition Prestige will pay the SSCF for an additional ten (10) elementary school students. The total mitigation fee is \$366,139 (April 2007) and exceeds the estimated school impact fees of \$360,614. The payment of this mitigation fee will be inclusive of all school impact fees and no further school mitigation will be required. Prestige Homes will enter into an agreement with the School Board restricting the subject property to the 232 units and the payment schedule for the mitigation fee as indicted in my February 15, 2007 letter. The proposed mitigation is consistent with School Board Policy and numerous mitigation agreements approved by the District.
