### Tentative Steering Committee Membership

4 Teachers	One elementary, middle, high, and center school teacher. Selected by the teachers association.
4 Principals	One principal selected by the administration.
1 Area Superintendent	Selected by district superintendent.
1 Support Staff	One support staff selected by the administration/maintenance.
2 School Board Members	Two school board members selected by the school board.
4 Parent Representatives	One parent from each area. Selection process to be determined.
2 Students	Two high school student selected by the student council.
4 Business Representatives	Two commercial/retail representative. Selection process to be determined.
1 Clergy Member	One clergy member selected informally by contacting area clergy to determine who they would like to have on the steering committee.
4 Government Representatives	Four representatives from townships, villages, and/or local government. Trustees are sent letters asking them to select a member to serve on the committee.
4 Civic Organization Members	Contact area civic organizations asking them to identify a representative to serve on the committee.
1 Charter 1 Private School Parent	Selection process to be determined.
3 Higher Education Representatives	One or two local college/university representatives, if applicable. Selection process to be determined, (BCC, NOVA, FAU).
1 Senior/Retirement	District to select 1 individual to represent the senior/retirement population.
1 Former Official	District to select 1 former district official.

Please note: Once the initial committee has been determined, it should be reviewed to make sure that it has geographical representation of the entire school district and balance of school and non-school employees.
