## RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF HIGH SCHOOL VOTER REGISTRATION WEEK September 15-19, 2008

WHEREAS, the state government of Florida has created Florida Statute 98.255 requiring Supervisor of Elections offices to hold voter registration drives to increase voter participation; and

WHEREAS, the state government of Florida has created Florida Administrative Code Rule 1S-2.033 requiring Supervisor of Elections offices to appear in each public high school in the county at least once per year; and

WHEREAS, high school seniors locally and across the country have shown great initiative and promise for America's future; and

WHEREAS, preserving America's democratic foundation has always been demonstrated on election days through our voting rights and responsibilities as citizens; and

WHEREAS, establishing relationships with organizations such as Kids Voting Broward and BSASC (Broward Schools Academic Student Council) will increase awareness and participation; and

WHEREAS, youth participation in the voting process is necessary for a stronger voice on issues pertaining to that specific age group; and

WHEREAS, voter registration and education as a proactive approach may strengthen chances for success on election days;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that The School Board of Broward County, Florida, in support of the state of Florida Statutes Section 98.255 and Florida Administrative Code Rule 1S-2.033 hereby declares

## **September 15-19, 2008** as

#### **High School Voter Registration Drive Week**

and calls for all high schools within its jurisdiction to observe this week with appropriate programs and activities.
