Dear Ms. Burke:

I am pleased to inform you that on March 11, 2008, the City of Fort Lauderdale's Commission awarded your association a grant of up to \$35,000 to implement a capital improvement project under the 2008 Neighborhood Capital Improvement Program (NCIP).

Under the terms of our agreement, your association's match consists of \$25,000 in cash contributions from The School Board of Broward County, \$4,900 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, contingent upon availability of funds, and 5,500 in Community Area Planning points. The estimated cost of your proposed project is \$64,900. Should the actual cost of the project exceed the estimated cost, the association has two options, (1) make up the excess in cash, or (2) reduce the scope of the project to accommodate the available funds.

The project scope approved for this grant includes the design and construction of intersection improvements at Southeast 15 Street and Southeast 10 Avenue. Location approval is contingent upon proposal meeting all engineering design standards. In addition, the City Commission has directed that all collector roads (i.e., Miami Road) shall use stamped asphalt in lieu of brick pavers.
