Any person who files an action protesting and intended decision shall post with the School Board, at the time of filing the formal written protest, a bond, payable to The School Board of Broward County, Florida, in an amount equal to one percent (1%) of the Board's estimate of the total volume of the contract. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed by Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or a failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.
