Failure to file a protest, or post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond, at the Facilities and Construction Management Division, 1700 SW 14th Court, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33312, within the time described in s.120.57(3), Florida Statutes, shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes. Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, states that the formal written protest shall state with particularity the facts and law upon which the protest is based.

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
